

STADIUM GROUND RULES

Entering the Stadium:

- 1. The management reserves the right to refuse entry to the Stadium for any reason.
- 2. Persons seeking entry to the Stadium may be required to submit to a search.
- 3. Alcohol, cans, bottles, fireworks, knives, hazardous items and other similar articles must not be brought into the stadium.
- 4. People with disabilities will be given special assistance where practicable.
- 5. All persons entering the Ground may only occupy the seat allocated to them by their ticket and must not move from any one part of the Ground to another without the express permission or instruction of any steward or security officer and/or any police officer.

General:

- 1. All persons in the stadium must follow any instructions given or displayed by the management (which in these Ground Rules includes the police, stewards and security staff as well as loud speaker and scoreboard announcements)
- 2. CCTV cameras are in use in and around the Stadium and images may be used by the management (and passed on to third parties) for any purpose.
- All persons entering the Stadium shall be deemed to agree to be bound by these Ground Rules.
- 4. In the event of the postponement or abandonment of the Event, refunds (if any) should be claimed in accordance with the relevant event organiser's ticket terms and conditions. Club will have no other liability whatsoever, including (but not limited to) any indirect or consequential loss or damage, such as (but not limited to) any indirect or consequential loss or damage, such as (but not limited to) loss of enjoyment or travel costs.

Inside the Stadium:

- 1. The management wishes to ensure that everyone in the Stadium has an enjoyable and safe experience. Failure to adhere to the Stadium ground rules will result in arrest and/or ejection from the Ground.
- 2. Consequently, the following is prohibited:
 - o Invading the pitch.
 - Consuming alcohol
 - Use of racist, obscene, abusive, threatening or offensive language or conduct.
 - Throwing any missile, object or article onto the pitch or anywhere else.
 - Damage to Stadium property.
 - o Behaving in a manner which disrupts the comfort, enjoyment or safety of others.
 - Persistent standing in the seated viewing areas.
 - o Smoking anywhere within the Stadium. The use of electronic cigarettes is also forbidden.
